




Gross Domestic Product (GDP) annual, current prices, USD billion







GDP by Sector sector as a % of GDP









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








Tax Residency compared






Individual Income Tax (IIT) tax brackets, USD current prices





	Jurisdiction	 Territorial Nationality (extraterritorial of Hong Kong citizens) Protective (extraterritorial regardless of nationality or criminality of act in jurisdiction of occurrence)
	Central Government Authority	Establishes new central government agency in Hong Kong – Office for Safeguarding National Security
	Concerns	 Criminal provisions worded broad manner to encompass what has so far been considered protected speech Provides for direct application of mainland Chinese law – the notoriously restrictive Criminal Procedure Law- in Hong Kong in certain circumstances
		Displaces certain core protections for accused under Hong Kong law and grants police sweeping investigative powers without judicial oversight


Office Vacancy Rate (grade A, central business district)


Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) flow, current prices, USD billion



Foreign Currency Movement commercial bank customer deposits, USD billion






